



Instructor - Job Description

Minimum Requirements:

Applicants must have daily access to a boat with a minimum 40 hp engine and the Pleasure Craft Operators license.

Applicants must possess their NLS, Red Cross Water Safety Instructor, Emergency First Aid, Standard First Aid and Lifesaving Society Instructor certification. Preference will be given to applicants with advanced swimming certifications and/or additional boating certifications.

Specific Responsibilities:

- responsible for teaching swimming lessons ranging from Parent and Tot to level 10, and possibly the Bronze Levels if certified.
 - participate in and lead the various activities that make up the Rec Program, including Cognashene Kinders, water sports, YPOC, etc.
 - when outings are scheduled, Instructors will be responsible to transport participants and or fellow instructors and volunteers to the predetermined destinations and back.
 - attend both the junior and senior canoe trips, including supervision and active participation.
 - attend and represent the recreation program at various community events taking place both within and outside the program, including Art on the Rocks, the Corn Roast, weekly meetings, end of year Beach Party, etc.
 - responsible for facilitating a safe, fun, and educational environment for all campers; show initiative in interacting with with both campers and parents
 - work as a member of the recreation program team with fellow instructors, assistant instructors and volunteers
 - must be friendly, responsible and have a willingness and strong initiative to actively participate in the various aspects of the program.

- help maintain Arthur Island beach and equipment (equipment, canoes, sailboats, buoys, etc)
 - other duties as discussed and assigned by Head of Program
